# Question: Are the Current Models of Orthopedic Practice Threatened?



# Recent Orthopedic Demographic Data:

- \*2008 AAOS data- decline in orthopedic surgeons in private practice from 72% to 65%
- \*2009 preliminary data: another 6-8% decline in private practice orthopedists
- \*New York times article: from 2005-8 the number of physicians in private practice declined from approx. 67% to 48%.

### Current and Anticipated Threats:

- \*- Declining reimbursement
- \*- Increasing complexity of practice
- \*- Unfunded state and federal mandates
- \*- Lack of tort reform
- \*- Increasing age of workforce
- \*- Competition from other models
- \*- Expectations of younger surgeons

# Anticipated Negative Results of Changes:

- Decreased physician autonomy and choice of practice setting
- Decreased patient choice
- Loss of private practice reimbursement benchmark
- Declining physician involvement in state and national societies
