This information is particularly important for orthopaedic surgeons who are involved in Foundation Model or employed arrangements, but also of interest to surgeons in private practice.

COA has purchased the 2021 Compensation and Productivity Data from the American Medical Group Association (AMGA) – who surveys large entities and complies this data annually - national data, as noted in their 5-year trend charts, and the west region data, which includes California. The reports include the following data points – median compensation, median work RVUs, compensation per work RVUs, median net collections, and median compensation to net collections for the following orthopaedic areas - Orthopedic Surgery, Orthopedic Sports Medicine, Orthopedic Joint Replacement and Orthopedic – Trauma. If there is another orthopaedic subspecialty area that you would like the data, we will see if AMGA has produced a 5-year trend report for that orthopaedic sub-specialty area and provide it to you if it is available.

Under our license agreement with AMGA, we are able to make the information available only to COA members upon request.

California Department of Industrial Relations

The Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) will hold a public meeting Nov. 30 to hear ideas to improve the efficiency and quality of care provided to injured workers. DWC hopes that a variety of interested stakeholders, including insurers, attorneys, employers and health care providers, will share their thoughts regarding providing quality care for injured workers and an efficient, cost effective system that offers fair compensation and minimizes frictional costs.

This is an opportunity to let the DWC know of your treatment delays, utilization review hassles, severe PPO discounts that are taken by payors, low reimbursement, and other issues that make injured workers more difficult and costly to treat.

We believe this is the beginning of efforts by the Division to update the OMFS – Treatment Fee Schedule. It is important for the Division and COA to hear your complaints. Please give us your input.
