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UnitedHealth's Limits on Out-of-Network Care Seen as Surprise Billing Ban Reaction

The big insurer unveiled restrictions on out-of-network coverage just days before CMS published an interim final rule banning much surprise billing. UnitedHealth Group's decision to end some out-of-network coverage caught providers by surprise, with many speculating the move is part of a broader set of policies by the nation's largest insurer aimed at controlling costs and lowering provider reimbursement.
